Related Project Experience

Columbus Municipal Airport Restaurant Renovation; Columbus, IN — Completed in 2017; This existing 1,700 sf restaurant located in the Columbus Municipal Airport wanted to upgrade their dining space finishes and furniture to coordinate with the recent lobby remodel. The project included installing all new finishes, installing specialty lighting, designing and selecting custom seating, creating a new layout and flow for the restaurant, and creating custom artwork. It was important that the restaurant only be shut down for a minimum amount of time thus requiring early ordering of some fixtures to make construction fast tracked.

Jackson Medical Building Lobby & Restrooms Renovations; Seymour, IN — \$225,000. Completed in 2015; This project included renovating 2,300 sf of an existing main entrance, elevator lobby, public restrooms, and main corridor of a medical office building. The interior work included all new finishes, new plumbing fixtures, reworking the existing HVAC system, selection of specialty light fixtures, custom artwork, and creating & reviewing furniture bid packages. Exterior work included reworking the existing storefront framing, installing new automatic sliding doors, replacing exterior glass, and relocating existing decorative concrete bollards.

Theta Chi Alpha IOTA Chapter Fraternity Renovations & Addition; Bloomington, IN — This project included multiple projects over the course of 2 years. The first renovation project called for upgrading finishes throughout their existing main entrance, trophy, and study room. The second renovation and addition project included inclosing the existing court yard, adding new public restrooms, a new brotherhood room and bike room.
